

MESSAGE FROM FR. MIKE

Before moving to Williamsburg I was stationed on the Lower East Side. One of my favorite places to visit was the Tenement Museum. It showcases the different immigrant groups that made their way to the United States to enjoy freedom and the pursuit of a better life. This past week we celebrated our nation's independence. For some we hear the stories of our forefathers and mothers making voyage to this new land. With little funds, limited language abilities but faith beyond all telling. Immigrants who built neighborhoods and communities, the City and the Church, and mindful of those who continue to come and build on those foundations. The Gospel this weekend reminds us that native Jesus was not accepted in his homeland. At times not even the foreigner is accepted in this homeland. The American hope is one that we are proud to be part of and continue to contribute life to the country's history.

When I was growing up in Bensonhurst there was an inscription over St. Finbar's school, "Pro Deus et Patria." As I reflect on our freedoms these past days I cannot help but think of the men and women in the armed forces that continue to defend and fight for our freedoms. I know that many of you have family members and friends of your friends' children who are serving our nation. The churches and neighborhood of our parish have produced proud service men and women, to whom we are immensely grateful. One of my goals as pastor is to honor them throughout the year, both during and also outside of the holidays.

I began this past week by concelebrating a funeral mass for Mary Jane Del Vicario. Although I never met her, I can tell from the stories and her commitment, especially to the hungry, that she was a woman who embodied Christian faith and the American graciousness that we all strive for. Mary Jane was truly a woman of the beatitudes. Last week June 27th marked Father Pedro's birthday. We wish him well in his new assignment as parochial vicar at Saint Joseph's in Astoria. We thank him for giving his life to serving and for the five years he shared it with our community. June 29th was the Feast of Saints Peter and Paul, which is also Fr. Rick's 28th anniversary of priestly ordination. He is a truly incredible man and in less than a year has done so much for the parish. I can truly say I stand on the shoulders of a giant. As I mentioned, I'd like to use this space to communicate. This past week I had some pre-existing commitments, so I was not able to celebrate some of the daily masses. I have shaved off my calendar but as life happens these were commitments I needed to be part of.

Antes de mudarme a Williamsburg estuve destinado en el Lower East Side. Uno de mis lugares favoritos para visitar fue el Museo Tenement. Muestra los diferentes grupos de inmigrantes que llegaron a los Estados Unidos para disfrutar de la libertad y la búsqueda de una vida mejor. La semana pasada celebramos la independencia de nuestra nación. Algunos escuchamos las historias de nuestros antepasados y madres que viajaron a esta nueva tierra. Con pocos fondos, habilidades lingüísticas limitadas pero una fe indescriptible. Inmigrantes que construyeron barrios y comunidades, la Ciudad y la Iglesia, y conscientes de aquellos que continúan viniendo y construyendo sobre esos cimientos. El Evangelio de este fin de semana nos recuerda que el Jesús nativo no fue aceptado en su tierra natal. A veces ni siquiera el extranjero es aceptado en esta patria. Estamos orgullosos de ser parte de la esperanza estadounidense y de continuar aportando vida a la historia del país.

Cuando yo era niño en Bensonhurst había una inscripción sobre la escuela de St. Finbar, "Pro Deus et Patria". Al reflexionar sobre nuestras libertades estos últimos días, no puedo evitar pensar en los hombres y mujeres de las fuerzas armadas que continúan defendiendo y luchando por nuestras libertades. Sé que muchos de ustedes tienen familiares y amigos de los hijos de sus amigos que sirven a nuestra nación. Las iglesias y el vecindario de nuestra parroquia han producido hombres y mujeres de servicio orgullosos, a quienes estamos inmensamente agradecidos. Una de mis metas como pastor es honrarlos durante todo el año, tanto durante como fuera de las fiestas.

Comencé la semana pasada concelebrando una misa fúnebre para Mary Jane Del Vicario. Aunque nunca la conocí, puedo decir por las historias y su compromiso, especialmente con los hambrientos, que ella era una mujer que encarnaba la fe cristiana y la bondad estadounidense por la que todos luchamos. Mary Jane fue verdaderamente una mujer de las bienaventuranzas. La semana pasada el 27 de junio se cumplió el cumpleaños del Padre Pedro. Le deseamos lo mejor en su nuevo cargo como vicario parroquial en Saint Joseph's en Astoria. Le agradecemos por entregar su vida al servicio y por los cinco años que la compartió con nuestra comunidad. El 29 de junio fue la fiesta de los Santos Pedro y Pablo, que también es la del P. 28º aniversario de la ordenación sacerdotal de Rick. Es un hombre realmente increíble y en menos de un año ha hecho mucho por la parroquia. Realmente puedo decir que estoy sobre los hombros de un gigante. Como mencioné, me gustaría usar este espacio para comunicarme. La semana pasada tuve algunos compromisos preexistentes, por lo que no pude celebrar algunas de las misas diarias. He recortado mi calendario, pero a medida que avanza la vida, estos eran compromisos de los que necesitaba ser parte.


