# MESSAGE FROM FR. MIKE

The Gospel this week asks an important question we all ask ourselves in our spiritual lives: "What must I do to gain eternal life?" Jesus says to the young man, let go of what you have and engage people. The most important part of life are our relationships. The young man's possessions stop him from relating outside his circle. We all have possessions but do we spend more times looking at our phones or in people's eyes and chatting with them? Essentially, do we possess our possessions or do our possessions possess us?

This weekend we also commemorate Columbus and Indigenous Peoples Day. We're grateful for the contributions of the Italian-American community to the fabric of American life and culture. We remember the contributions of Italian culture to the life of our neighborhood and parish. A film that has impressed me recently was CABRINI, honoring the life of St Frances Cabrini, a woman who came with great faith to serve the Italian community, and her mission extended to all peoples. In observance of the holiday the rectory office will be closed but the Monday mass schedule is normal.

Last weekend we celebrated the feast of St Francis of Assisi. It was a wonderful celebration on the 4th, and on the 6th we blessed dogs and cats in our neighborhood. Many came out, parishioners and non-parishioners, Catholics and non-Catholics to celebrate creation in the Franciscan spirit. I'm grateful for the volunteers who helped set up the event. We continue to honor creation in his spirit.

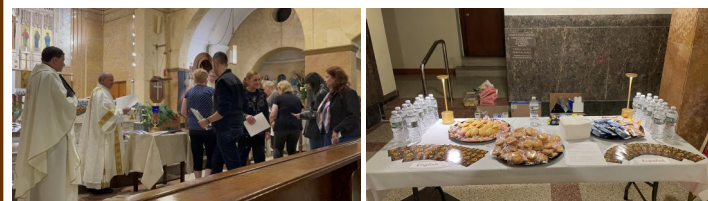


## 2025 Mass Book Opens From January to June

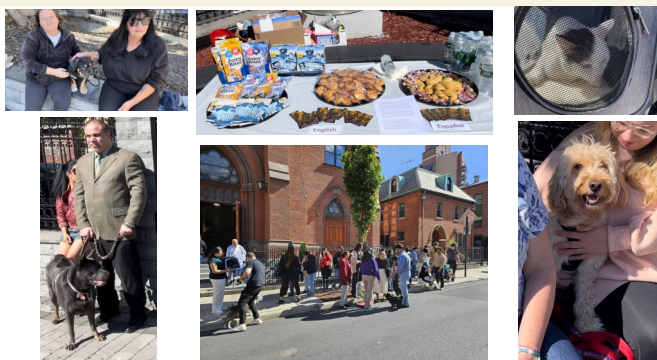


# Blessing of the Animals
