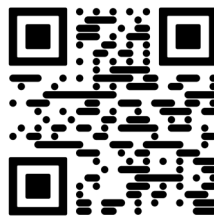

MESSAGE FROM FR. MIKE

"Amen, I say to you, this poor widow put in more than all the other contributors to the treasury. For they have all contributed from their surplus wealth, but she, from her poverty, has contributed all she had, her whole livelihood." This weekend we hear of the parable of the widow's mite. In addition to this Gospel, we celebrate Mother Cabrini with a Celebration of Cultures. Mother Cabrini came to the United States and built an empire of love, founding more than 60 institutions throughout the Americas, including schools, hospitals, and orphanages, as well as a Religious Order. She was the first naturalized U.S. citizen to be canonized. Many of our own families and parishioners or their foreparents came with very little, worked hard, built and passed on. In my own life when I leave I try to make sure I have everything that I need but that wasn't the case. It's also a reminder that as we evangelize it's the spirit of the widow's mite; let's invest what we have and see the fruits born from it.

The Rosary Society is leading a Thanksgiving drive to help Bridge To Life, a wonderful diocesan organization that helps parents of newborns to help sustain and support life. In the spirit of serving, please contribute an item for a baby either at the St Ann statue at the entrance of St Cecilia Church, the office or sacristy at St Francis, or in the sacristy at St. Nicholas. On November 24th, following the 9:30 Mass we will have our Parish Communion Breakfast. My hope is that many across our worship sites will come and celebrate our parish family at 10:30am at St Cecilia gym (see more information in the bulletin).

This weekend we remember our Veterans. Quite often many of our veterans are overlooked, rarely thanked, and under appreciated. They have made great sacrifices to protect and secure our freedoms, at times at great expense. Please thank a veteran and/or offer a prayer for them. The office will be closed Monday for Veterans Day, but we will have Mass at St Francis (9am) and St Cecilia (11:30am).

"En verdad os digo que esta viuda pobre echó más que todos los demás contribuyentes al tesoro. Porque todos contribuyeron con su excedente de riqueza, pero ella, con su pobreza, contribuyó con todo lo que tenía, con todo su sustento." Este fin de semana escuchamos de la parábola de la óbola de la viuda. Además de este Evangelio, celebramos a Madre Cabrini con una Celebración de las Culturas. La Madre Cabrini llegó a los Estados Unidos y construyó un imperio de amor, fundando más de 60 instituciones en todo el continente americano, incluidas escuelas, hospitales y orfanatos, así como una Orden Religiosa. Fue la primera ciudadana estadounidense naturalizada en ser canonizada. Muchas de nuestras propias familias y feligreses o sus antepasados vinieron con muy poco, trabajaron duro, construyeron y transmitieron. En mi propia vida, cuando salgo trato de asegurarme de tener todo lo que necesito, pero ese no fue el caso. También es un recordatorio de que a medida que evangelizamos, es el espíritu de la óbola de la viuda; invirtamos lo que tenemos y veamos los frutos que nacen de ello.

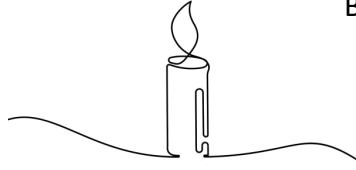
