"The harvest is abundant, but the laborers are few; so ask the master of the harvest to send out laborers for his harvest."

I am intentional about praying for vocations to the consecrated life, married life, priesthood, and diaconate at Mass. As I mark 11 years of ordination this weekend, I am grateful for the gift of my priestly vocation and life. Last week, our Diocese ordained a new priest, and with joy, the Diocese welcomed him. I am also mindful that for every new priest ordained, many others are retiring. As I look out at our congregation, I am inspired by the many young adult faces who are zealously committed to prayer and serving others. As the Gospel reminds us, the laborers are few, and the harvest is great. If anyone is considering a priestly or religious vocation, please don't hesitate to talk to me or our Diocesan vocation director, Fr. Chris Bethge.

This weekend, our St. Anthony Society celebrates its patron saint. More than a patron of finding lost things, St. Anthony is a man whose faith life has inspired centuries of faithful. He was born in Portugal and joined the Augustinian monastery in Lisbon. After witnessing the life of the first Franciscans, he transferred from the Augustinian Abbey to the Franciscan friars, where he briefly met St. Francis. At an ordination, when the preacher failed to show, he stepped in and his reputation for preaching and teaching the Word of God began. On Saturday, we will honor the memory of St. Anthony at Mass, and the Society will distribute bread. If you are interested in joining the Society, speak to a member or call the rectory.

Starting on the weekend of July 5th, the 9:30am Mass will be held in the air-conditioned St. Cecilia's gym. I know some people are unhappy with the move from the Church, but it is necessary due to the excruciating heat. On the following weekend, the parish will host the annual Mission Mass. Fr. Nathaniel Eke, Provincial of the Claretians in East Nigeria, will be joining us. There will be a second collection that weekend to benefit the mission work of the Claretians in Nigeria.

Como nos recuerda el Evangelio, los obreros son pocos y la cosecha es grande. Si alguien está considerando una vocación sacerdotal o religiosa, por favor no dude en hablar conmigo o con nuestro director diocesano de vocaciones, el P. Chris Bethge.

Este fin de semana, nuestra Sociedad de San Antonio celebra a su santo patrón. Más que un patrón para encontrar cosas perdidas, San Antonio es un hombre cuya vida de fe ha inspirado a generaciones de fieles a lo largo de los siglos. Nació en Portugal e ingresó en el monasterio agustino de Lisboa. Tras conocer la vida de los primeros franciscanos, pasó de la abadía agustina a la orden franciscana, donde llegó a conocer brevemente a San Francisco. Durante una ceremonia de ordenación, ante la ausencia del predicador previsto, él tomó la palabra, dando así inicio a su fama como predicador y maestro de la Palabra de Dios. El sábado honraremos la memoria de San Antonio en Misa y la Sociedad repartirá pan. Si le interesa unirse a la Sociedad, hable con alguno de sus miembros o llame a la rectoría.

A partir del fin de semana del 5 de julio, la Misa de las 9:30 a. m. se celebrará en el gimnasio de Santa Cecilia, que cuenta con aire acondicionado.
