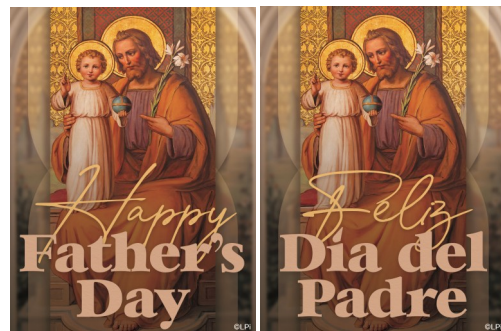

"...grace of God and the gracious gift of the one man Jesus Christ overflow for the many."

On June 11 at 4:00p.m. at the Basilica Shrine of Mary, Queen of the Universe in Orlando, Florida, the bishops of the United States consecrated our nation to the Sacred Heart of Jesus in anticipation of the country's 250th anniversary. A consecration is an act of entrustment to God. In the Scriptures, Jesus reminds us: "Fear no person or thing." Fear is a reality that we all face. It is a recognition of what could happen. Yet if we become stuck in the "what ifs," we fail to see what can happen through God's grace. Many fears and concerns weigh heavily on people's hearts—concerns about their personal lives, the state of our country and world, our communities, and even the Church. Recognizing fear is healthy; remaining trapped in fear is not. As we enter this period of consecration, let us not remain focused on "What if?" Instead, let us ask, "What can be?" With faith in the Sacred Heart of Jesus, may we move forward with hope, trust, and confidence in God's providence.

Starting on the weekend of July 5th, the 9:30am Mass will be held in the air-conditioned St. Cecilia's gym. I know some people are unhappy with the move from the Church, but it is necessary due to the excruciating heat. On the following weekend, the parish will host the annual Mission Mass. Fr. Nathaniel Eke, Provincial of the Claretians in East Nigeria, will be joining us. There will be a second collection at each Mass that weekend to benefit the mission work of the Claretians in Nigeria.

El 11 de junio a las 4:00p.m. en el Santuario Basílica de María, Reina del Universo, en Orlando, Florida, los obispos de los Estados Unidos consagraron nuestra nación al Sagrado Corazón de Jesús en preparación para el 250 aniversario del país. Una consagración es un acto de entrega a Dios. En las Escrituras, Jesús nos recuerda: "No teman a ninguna persona ni cosa." El miedo es una realidad a la que todos nos enfrentamos; es reconocer lo que podría suceder. Sin embargo, si nos quedamos atrapados en los "¿y si...?", no logramos ver lo que puede suceder gracias a la gracia de Dios. Muchos temores y preocupaciones pesan en el corazón de las personas: inquietudes sobre su vida personal, el estado de nuestro país y del mundo, nuestras comunidades e incluso la Iglesia. Reconocer el miedo es saludable; quedarse atrapado en él, no. Al comenzar este periodo de consagración, no nos centremos en el "¿y si...?" En su lugar, preguntémonos: "¿Qué es posible?". Con fe en el Sagrado Corazón de Jesús, avancemos con esperanza, confianza y seguridad en la providencia divina.

A partir del fin de semana del 5 de julio, la Misa de las 9:30a.m. se celebrará en el gimnasio de Santa Cecilia, que cuenta con aire acondicionado. Sé que a algunas personas les disgusta el traslado desde el templo principal, pero es necesario debido al calor sofocante. El fin de semana siguiente, la parroquia acogerá la Misa anual de las Misiones. Nos acompañará el P. Nathaniel Eke, provincial de los claretianos en Nigeria Oriental. En cada Misa de ese fin de semana habrá una segunda colecta destinada a apoyar la labor misionera de los claretianos en Nigeria.
