MESSAGE FROM FR. MIKE

On the weekend of July 12, the second collection will support the mission work of the Claretians in Nigeria.

"The Claretian Missionaries is a religious Missionary Congregation founded by St. Anthony Mary Claret, in Spain, in 1849. Our Charism in the Church is to preach the Word of God using all possible means.

We Claretian Missionaries are presently involved in parish ministry teaching retreat preaching and publication. We work in more than 60 countries of the world.

In Nigeria we build and run schools to give quality and sound education to the youths. These schools are necessary because the government neglected this sector for a long time. We are also involved in Justice and Peace initiatives to empower the people like helping the poor and orphans get sponsors so that at least they can eat.

Recently Nigeria has had a lot of social unrest perpetrated by the Islamic fundamentalists known as BOKO HARAM (ISIS). This group promotes terrorism and violence at different levels. They operate more in Northern Nigeria where we have a good number of our Missionaries working. Terrorism and insurgency in northern part of the country is affecting the Christians who dwell there. The violence being unleashed on the Christians has put them to fear, displacement and hunger and we as missionaries cannot fold our arms and watch our fellow missionaries and their parishioners suffer. Bombs have exploded and killed several Christians during Worship. Despite the violence, there is still hope of a flourishing faith.

To make matters worse, the COVID-19 pandemic with its economic and social effects brought hunger and death in the country. The palliatives provided by the government and non-governmental organizations (NGOs) were hoarded by corrupt politicians. The church becomes solace of the poor and marginalized.

We also have a good number of young people who knock at our door indicating their interests to join us in the missionary work we do. We thank God for the increase in vocation to priesthood but most often we are financially handicapped as to take care of the needs of these young men so that the work of evangelization will continue to spread.

Through your donations we the Claretian Missionaries will carry on with the work of evangelization. God bless you as you help us."

El fin de semana del 12 de julio, la segunda colecta apoyará la labor misionera de los claretianos en Nigeria.

"Fue el Arzobispo Fulton Sheen quien dijo que si el hombre no se salva nada quedara salvado. Esto es verdad porque la voluntad de Dios es que todo el mundo se salve y llegue a conocer la Verdad (1Timoteo 2,4).

Por esa misma salvacion del hombre estoy aqui entre vosotros mis amigos, en el nombre de los Misioneros Claretianos. La Congregacion Claretiana fue fundada en 1849 en Espana por San Antonio Maria Claret. Estoy aqui para pedir ayuda economica para que podamos continuar las obras evangelizadoras que llevamos en la Iglesia y en todos los continentes del mundo.

Nosotros Claretianos trabajamos en las parroquias, algunos como profesores, otros como animadores de los ejercicios espirituales y otros en las publicaciones claretianas. Actualmente trabajamos en mas desesenta y cinco (60) paises del mundo.

Vivo y trabajo en Nigeria un pais del Oeste de Africa. Alli trabajamos con los jovenes en las escuelas que hemos construido para dar una educacion de buena calidad a los jovenes sabiendo que el gobierno de Nigeria ha fracasado en este sentido de educar a los ninos y jovenes. Llevamos obras de la justicia y paz entre los mas pobres. Algunos ninos pobres necesitan apadrinamiento para que puedan vivir dignamente como seres humanos.

Ultimamente Nigeria esta sufriendo la violencia y terrorismo islamico sobre todo en el norte donde nuestros misioneros estan trabajando. Los musulmanes fundamentalistas bombardean las Iglesias y otros lugares del culto Cristiano matando a muchos cristianos. No podemos abandonar estos lugares aunque nos amenazan por que todavia hay gente Cristiana alli. Los misioneros que trabajan en estos lugares necesitan ayudas economicas tanto para ellos como para los feligreses pobres que estan desplazados por la violencia.

En Nigeria y en otros paises de Africa tenemos muchas vocaciones a la vida religiosa y sacerdotal. Muchos jovenes quieren ser misioneros pero no podemos ingresar a muchos que quieren y buscan a server a Dios porque no tenemos los medios economicos para formarlos. Si nos ayudan economicamente hoy, saben que nos estan ayudando para formar a los futuros evangelizadores para la Iglesia.

Os pedimos sus oraciones y ayudas porque donde no pueden llegar físicamente sus oraciones y ayudas pueden llegar.

Ayudadnos a predicar el evangelio, ayudadnos a ayudar a los mas pobres. Que Dios les bendiga. Amen!"
